In accordance with the Ministerial Decision no (19) dated November 22nd, 2024, regarding the admission criteria, allowing the universities to determine their own admission criteria.

Below are the admission criteria and proficiency test requirements for all programs offered by Umm Al Quwain University (UAQU) in both English and Arabic, as well as for Bachelor's and Master's programs per college.

These proficiency test requirements ensure that students from various academic backgrounds have various pathways to meet the necessary proficiency criteria for their chosen programs, thereby supporting the achievement of program outcomes.

General Terms

- For missing proficiency tests the applicants can be conditionally accepted for one academic year.
- These proficiency criteria will be applied for both new and conditional continued students.
- Students who have completed non-Ministry of Education high school curricula do not need to prove their English proficiency if the program is taught in English
- Applicants whose high school average is less than 60% may be accepted after register/Pass in 3 remedial courses English, Math and Arabic conducted by UAQU
