



Recommended Admission Criteria

With reference to the Ministerial Resolution No (19) of 2024 on the admission criteria in Higher Education Institutions, GMU recommends

 Successful completion of High school (Grade 12/13) with minimum subject competencies as follows:

Programs	Subject Competency for UAE /US curriculum			
	Biology	Chemistry	Physics*	Mathematics*
Medicine	90	90	70	70
Dentistry	85	85	70	70
Pharmacy	80	80	70	70

^{*}Physics OR Mathematics for Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy programs

- **Subject competency:** Two sciences, Biology and Chemistry, recommended as mandatory for all programs with Physics or Mathematics as the third subject.
- Recommend Physics or Mathematics: Some of the International Education systems in UAE such as Indian, Pakistan, UK does not cover mathematics for science track in High school, instead they cover Physics. Therefore, we recommend the subject competency as Physics or Mathematics completed either in Grade 11 or Grade 12, in Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy Programs.
- **Minimum score for subject competency** for international students' high school score shall be equivalized with UAE system based on **WES** *International grading equivalency system*.

Applicants who lack the subject competency shall be advised to take a non-credit Foundation/ Bridging program in the FALL semester and pass.

English Proficiency Requirements:

- Professional degree programs with international recognition such as Medicine, Biomedical Science and Higher Diploma in Clinical Sciences with international tracks require standardised English Proficiency scores irrespective of high school medium of instruction.
- International curriculum students who have completed in their national language is required to pass standardised English Proficiency scores (IELTS – 5.0 or TOEFL 61) except Medicine for undergraduate studies.
- All students from UAE education system are required to score 80% in English in Grade 12 for eligibility into undergraduate programs. Failing which, student is conditionally admitted and required to pass the remedial course.
- All International curriculum with English medium of instruction in high school is required to submit English score equivalent to UAE 80%.
